
Waikato Respiratory Virus Report

Week to 15 Mar 2020

There are very few of the traditional winter viruses circulating yet. We found zero cases of Influenza and RSV last week (26 patients tested). The New Zealand situation is still not conducive to rapid spread of respiratory viruses.

Testing for SARS-CoV-2, the cause of COVID-19 illness, is now under way at Waikato Hospital lab. Testing was expanded to travellers who had arrived from any overseas country after 1 March (https://www.health.govt.nz/our-work/diseases-and-conditions/covid-19-novel-coronavirus). So far, very little testing has been done to search for local transmission within NZ.
