
## Waikato Respiratory Virus Report

Week to 22 Nov 2020

COVID test numbers are up to around 2200 each week and a small number of positives have been found in our managed isolation facilities. Most of these people are well, have low virus levels and already have antibodies, suggesting the infections were some weeks or months before travelling to New Zealand. Rhinoviruses, Parainfluenzavirus type 1, seasonal coronaviruses and adenoviruses are circulating in the Waikato.
