
## Waikato Respiratory Virus Report

Week to 19 Jan 2021

Influenza A, B and RSV remain absent from the region.

SARS-CoV-2 test numbers are declining, eroding our capability to quickly detect community transmission when it happens. In recent months, the only cases being detected have been in returned travellers in the managed isolation facilities. We have a diverse range of rhinoviruses, adenoviruses, parainfluenzaviruses and the traditional coronaviruses circulating.
