
Waikato Respiratory Virus Report

11 July 2022

Influenza has peaked and will decline from now on. This has been Influenza A H3N2 and the strain used in the vaccine was well matched to those found in NZ. We may yet see A H1N1 or one of the two B lineages circulate later in the winter. RSV is starting to build up. A diversity of other viruses is also present, with the rhinoviruses, adenoviruses, human metapneumovirus and parainfluenzavirus 4 all circulating.
