
Waikato Respiratory Virus Report

2 August 2022

We have found one case of Influenza B last week. This does not seem to have expanded much in other parts of the world and is not established in New Zealand at present. Influenza A H3N2 continues to decline and Rhinovirus numbers are also falling. Note that assays in use at Waikato Hospital don't distinguish between Rhino- and Entero-viruses, so the nominal Rhinovirus count is both these closely related groups combined. RSV numbers continue to slowly increase. Not many other viruses were found on extended panel testing.
