
## Waikato Respiratory Virus Report

20 Sept 2022

Test numbers remain high. About 300 samples each week are sent from the Emergency Department, screening people with respiratory tract illness for RSV and SARS-CoV-2, to enable appropriate isolation measures when admitted to hospital. Rhinoviruses continue to circulate and there are also small numbers of metapneumovirus, parainfluenzavirus 3 and seasonal (non-covid) coronavirus cases.
